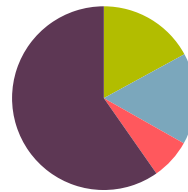
Advocacy

We mobilize members to champion and challenge public policies that impact member work.

- Provided free capacity building assistance to **three member organizations**



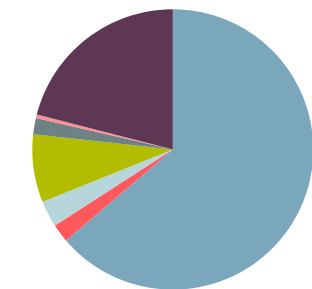
Community Building & Connecting

- Connected with **89 members** at Regional Member meetings



Revenue



- Grants - 63%
- Membership dues - 8%

Funding

We provide members with fundraising support through lending, grant making, and grant writing services to support member projects.



- Awarded **\$400,000** to fund solar panels for low-income individuals through Solar Uniting Neighbors (SUN)
- Established the **Prosperity Indiana Fund**
- **Over 900** employer-based, small-dollar loans made by members participating in the Community Loan Center (CLC) program
